R. v. Trbojevic

REASONS FOR JUDGMENT

CULVER, J. (Orally):

This is an appeal from a conviction for speeding; the offence being speeding at 60 kilometres per hour in a 50 kilometre per hour zone, contrary to the provisions of the Highway Traffic Act.

The appeal is based on an omission in the completion of the Certificate of Offence; and the appeal is from the conviction in absentia of the accused and a deemed not to dispute procedure by a justice of the peace.

The omission in this case is at the top of the certificate, where the time of the offence is absent. The year is 2007, clearly marked; the month 09 for September, and the day the 20th are marked, but not the time of the offence.

There is a long line of authority that is referred to by Justice Libman in the case of R. v. Khoshael, (2001) OJ No. 2110, that stands for the proposition that where a defect appears in a certificate of offence under Section 9.1, such that it cannot be said to be complete and regular on its face, the result must be a quashing order.

This is distinct from extra or surplusage information on the Certificate of Offence.

In other words, there cannot be too much information necessarily on a Certificate of Offence, but there certainly can be too little.

In this case, the time block is completely blank.

In my view, the Certificate of Offence is therefore not complete and regular on its face.

In my view, the justice of the peace erred in not quashing the Certificate.

The appeal is therefore allowed; and the Certificate is quashed.
