## The \$ and ¢ of it

Have you ever wondered about the true value of a \$10.00 cab ride or a designated driver?

Here's an example of minimum costs to an impaired driver...

Criminal Code Fine .....\$600 Payable to the Government of Canada

Remedial Measures Program .......... \$475 Payable to Back on Track + GST

Licence Reinstatement Fee ......\$100
Payable to Ministry of Finance + GST

Increase in Insurance costs\* .... \$9,000\* Payable to your insurance company in \$3,000 increments each of the next 3 years

\*minimum increase based on a perfect 6-star driving record

Ignition Interlock ..... + installation. Pay to interlock provider

Court costs .....\$2,000 - \$10,000 Payable to your legal counsel





## IMPAIRED DRIVING - MINIMUM PENALTIES

OFFENCE	ONTARIO HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ACT	CRIMINAL CODE
First	1 year licence suspension* Remedial measures requirement 1 year ignition interlock condition upon reinstatement**	1 year driving prohibition \$600 fine
Second	3 year licence suspension* Remedial measures requirement 3 year ignition interlock condition upon reinstatement**	2 year driving prohibition 14 day jail sentence
Third	Lifetime licence suspension* (reducible to 10 years if certain conditions are met) Ignition interlock condition for life if suspension reduced**	3 year driving prohibition 90 day jail sentence
Fourth & Subsequent	Lifetime licence suspension*	Same as third offence

"As of December 23, 2001, any driver who commits and is subsequently a Griminal Code conviction will have the vehicle they are driving impounded for a minimum of 45 days and face fines of \$5,000 to \$50,000.

This means that, dher reinstant, if the individual wishes to drive it must be in a vehicle that is equipped with an approved ignition interlock device.
